

ICU Guidelines

8:25—The ICU report is run and printed. This report will determine which students need to report to the special SRB and/or stay after school.

During 1st Period—Mr. Sommervold and Mrs. Welch distribute the ICU slips to the classrooms/students.

At DVHS every student will complete every assignment with a minimum score of 64.5% (D-). The students need to learn the material not just complete the assignment.

Any student with 1 to 3 missing assignments on the ICU list will stay in their assigned SRB the entire 90 minutes unless they have pass from another teacher.

Any student with 4 or more missing assignments:

- Will report to another SRB room after SRB focus time.
- Will be required to stay after school from 3:15 until 3:50 Monday through Thursday.
 - o If a student started the day with 4 or more missing assignments but completed enough assignments to have 3 or fewer by SRB or 3:15, they are no longer required to leave their assigned SRB and are allowed to leave school @ 3:15.
- During the afterschool ICU time:
 - o Students with 4 or more missing assignments @ 3:15, will stay until **ALL** of the assignments are complete or 3:50.
 - o If a student needs help, the teacher will be called to the SRB room instead of the student going to the teacher.
 - o A student with 4 or more missing assignments will not leave ICU time to attend a practice until after 3:50pm, unless the student completes **ALL** missing assignments.
 - o Any student needing to leave school for an extra-curricular event will be allowed to leave, as long as the student is academically eligible.
- Any student with 8+ missing assignments on the ICU list needs significant time and help to catch up. The student will therefore be removed from normal classes to complete all of the missing work. When ALL of the missing assignments are completed with quality, the students will return to class.

Teacher In-Service for 1:30 Releases:

- Students with **ANY** missing assignments will be required to attend school during this Teacher In-Service time. This is a great time to receive the extra help and extra time necessary to learn the material and get caught up.

Students that are not on the ICU list will randomly be rewarded.

- The rewards will take form in many different ways and will be random. Some of the rewards will be in the form of a drawing and other rewards will be for all students not on the ICU list.
 - o The purpose is to acknowledge students who do well without incentives, which is why it is random.
